I got my qualification at the Mauritius National Swimming Championships in May, finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> on the 200m FS (Freestyle) in 2'04"38 and 2<sup>nd</sup> on the 400m FS in 4'26"18.



I'm very satisfied with my performances in Seychelles, I did my PB's and had a huge time progress in two month.

I finished 4<sup>th</sup> on the 200m FS in 2'01"32 (2'04"38 in May)

I finished 3<sup>rd</sup> on the 400m FS in 4'19"12 (4'26"18 in May)

And we finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the relay 4\*200m

Seychelles was a great experience and I enjoyed the team spirit. I'm now back in triathlon training with my major goal on the 4<sup>th</sup> September in Mozambique for the African games. Then will start the African Cups all over Africa and my season will end with the Mauritius African Cup in December.
